# AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

State owned submerged lands in Huntington Harbour, Huntington Beach, Orange County.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

The continued use and maintenance of an existing boat dock.

# **LEASE TERM:**

Ten years, beginning October 5, 2002.

#### CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.


# SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$300,000.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. At its meeting on November 15, 1994, pursuant to Minute Item 81, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier lease with the applicants. That lease expires October 4, 2002. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling. Applicants are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.



# CALENDAR ITEM NO. C25 (CONT'D)

Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370 et seq.
