RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Bernard G. Shute and Florence Margaret Shute 5311 Garden Highway Sacramento, CA 95837

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands near the Garden Highway, in the Sacramento River, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 32 foot by 8 foot floating dock and a 2 foot by 14 foot walkway.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning March 30, 2002.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On September 23, 1992, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Bernard G. Shute and Florence Margaret Shute. That lease expires on March 29, 2002. Bernard G. Shute and Florence Margaret Shute are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicants are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.

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CALENDAR ITEM NO. C28 (CONT'D)

 Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


