AMENDMENT OF DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

Port of Oakland 530 Water Street Oakland, CA 94501

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Legislatively granted sovereign lands with minerals reserved to the State at Port of Oakland, Berths 59 through 63, portions of Jack London Square Marina, and Estuary Park marinas, located in the city of Oakland, Alameda County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Maintenance dredge a maximum of 300,000 cubic yards of material to maintain a navigable depth. Dredged materials will be disposed of at the United States Army Corps of Engineers designated disposal sites at SF-11 (Alcatraz), SF-DODS (Deep Ocean Disposal Site) and Montezuma Wetlands Restoration Project.

LEASE TERM:

Five years beginning April 15, 2003.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

The previous Lease, authorized by the Commission at its April 7, 2003, meeting, designated the Leased Lands as Port of Oakland, Berths 59 through 63, located at the Port of Oakland in the city of Oakland, Alameda County. This Amendment modifies the Leased Lands to include: Berths 59 through 63, portions of Jack London Square Marina, and Estuary Park marinas, located at the Port of Oakland in the city of Oakland, Alameda County. The previous Lease authorized the maintenance dredging of a maximum of 80,000 cubic yards of material. This Amendment modifies the authorization to allow for the dredging of 300,000 cubic yards of material.

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CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged; \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any material used for private benefit or commercial sale purposes.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. This project is part of a larger dredging project (617,000 cubic yards) at the Port of Oakland. No lease is required for the dredging of 317,000 cubic yards that will occur on that portion of land that has been granted to the city of Oakland (lessee) with no minerals reserved to the State.
- 2. The Port of Oakland, as the lead agency under the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), determined that the project (maintenance dredging, 2003 to 2008) is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304 (g). Staff concurs with such determination.

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT WITHOUT AMENDMENT.


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
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Exhibit A Location Map – PRC 7483
