AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the San Joaquin River, city of Lathrop, San Joaquin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance for an existing ramp and floating boat dock.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning April 28, 2003.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On July 5, 1994, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with William Martin Schendel. That lease expired April 27, 2003. William Martin Schendel is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and uses the upland for, a single-family dwelling.






SITE
