## CONSIDER AMENDMENT TO COMPENSATORY ROYALTY AGREEMENT NOS. PRC 2908.1 AND PRC 2990.1, GRIMES AND SYCAMORE AREA, COLUSA AND SUTTER COUNTIES

#### **APPLICANT:**

#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Compensatory Royalty Agreement No. PRC 2908.1 contains approximately 640 acres in the vicinty of the Grimes area of the Sacramento River, Colusa and Sutter Counties. Compensatory Royalty Agreement No. PRC 2990.1 contains approximately 108.40 acres in the Sycamore area of the Sacramento River, Colusa and Sutter Counties.

#### BACKGROUND:

Compensatory Royalty Agreement No. PRC 2908.1 was issued to Patrick A. Doheny on June 28, 1962. Compensatory Royalty Agreement No. PRC 2990.1 was issued to Patrick A. Doheny on January 28, 1965. Through various assignments and name changes, Tri-Union Development Corporation (Tri-Union) has been the operator for these agreements since 1965. On June 18, 2003, California State Lands Commission (Commission) staff received a request from Tri-Union for an amendment of these agreements to allow Tri-Union to pay royalty on the natural gas produced under these agreements on the 25<sup>th</sup> of the second month following the month of production. At the present time, royalty payments for PRC 2908.1 and PRC 2990.1 are due on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the month following the month of production. its gas purchaser, due to marketing changes, is unable to provide Tri-Union with accurate sales information in time to allow it to meet the current contractural deadlines for payment of State royalty. Since Tri-Union has an excellent lease compliance record, and does not have complete and accurate information available to meet the present payment schedule, Commission staff recommends that the Commission approve amending the agreements to allow payment by the 25<sup>th</sup> of the second month following the month of gas production retroactive to January 1, 2003.
