DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

Benicia Port Terminal Company
P.O. Box 315
Benicia, CA 94510

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Carquinez Strait at the Benicia Port Terminal Dock, city of Benicia, Solano County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Dredge a maximum of 90,000 cubic yards of material annually over five years to maintain a navigable depth. Dredged materials will be disposed of at United States Army Corps of Engineers designated disposal site SF-9 (Carquinez Strait).

LEASE TERM:

Five years, beginning November 13, 2003

CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged; \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any material used for private benefit or commercial sale purposes.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304 (g).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300.

2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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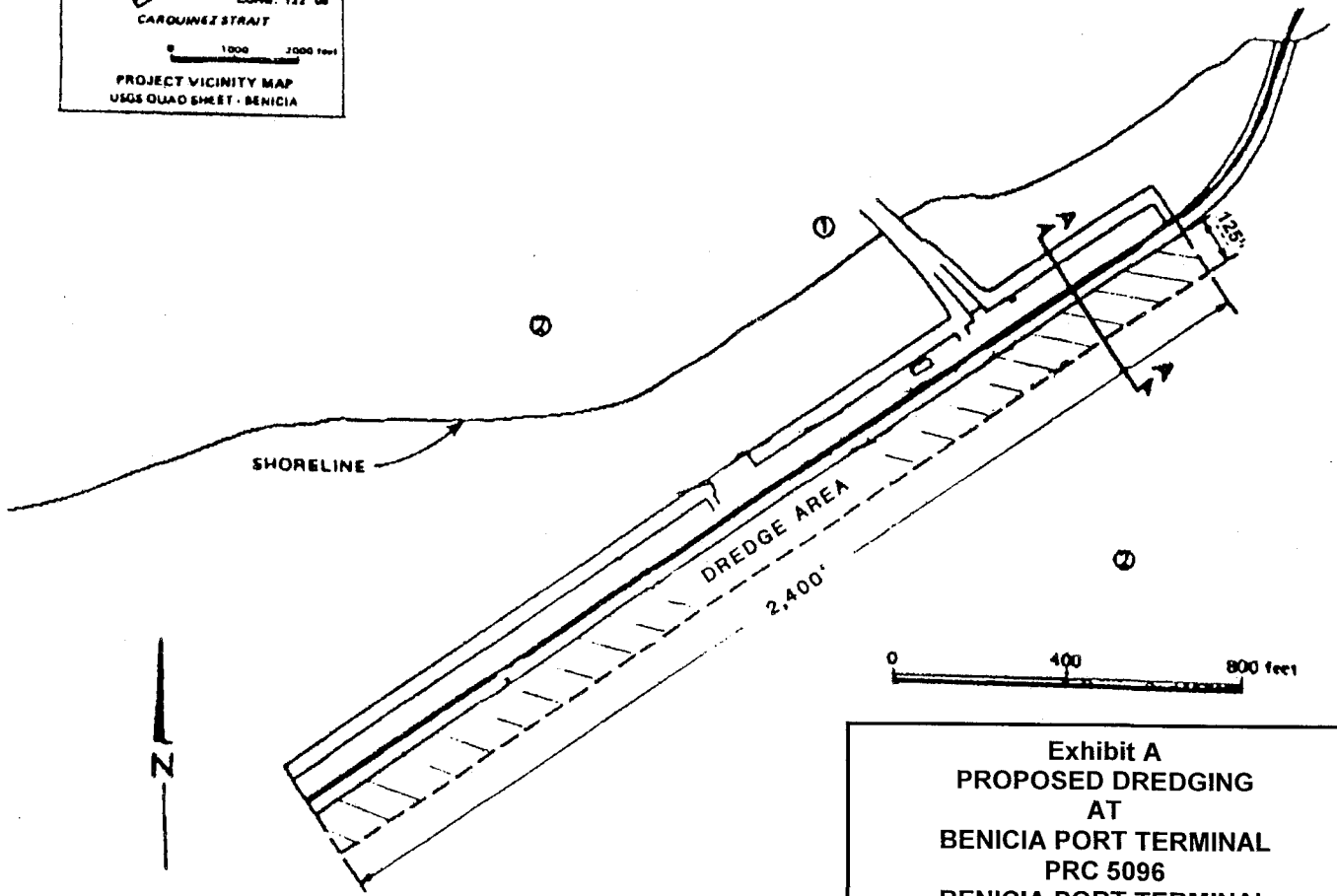
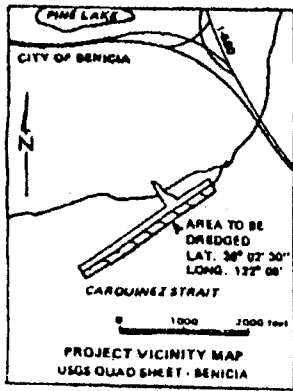

NOVEMBER 12, 2008, FOR DREDGING A MAXIMUM OF 90,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL ANNUALLY FROM THE CARQUINEZ STRAIT AT THE BENICIA PORT TERMINAL DOCK AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF. DREDGED MATERIALS WILL BE DISPOSED OF AT THE U.S ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS DESIGNATED DISPOSAL SITE SF-9 (CARQUINEZ STRAIT). SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. NO ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED, AS THE PROJECT WILL RESULT IN A PUBLIC BENEFIT; \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR ANY MATERIAL USED FOR PRIVATE BENEFIT OR FOR COMMERCIAL SALE PURPOSES.
