Controller Steve Westly, Chair, called the regular meeting of the California State Lands Commission to order at 2:01 p.m., at the Ferry Building Marketplace, Board Commission Hearing Room, 2nd Floor, One Ferry Building, San Francisco, California 94111.

The minutes of the December 9, 2003 meeting were approved as presented.

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RECORD OF ACTION TAKEN BY THE CALIFORNIA STATE LANDS COMMISSION MEETING OF FEBRUARY 2, 2004

Calendar Items C07 and C43 were removed from the agenda to be heard at a subsequent meeting.

The recommendation of staff, relative to Calendar Items C01-C06, C08-C25, C27-C42, and C44-49 were approved by unanimous vote of Commission Chair Cruz Bustamante; Controller Steve Westly; and Fred Klass, Commission alternate for Department of Finance.

Calendar Item 26: The Commission was asked to approve a five-year lease for a Duke Energy pipeline. The lease was approved by unanimous vote but amended to reflect: 1) shorten the proposed lease from five years to two years, 2) require that the environmental review necessary for removal or determination by the Commission as to what to do with the physical improvements would be completed -- begun and completed in time so that it would be available at the end of the two-year lease, and 3) that should any reuse of the pipeline be proposed by Duke, such as for a fiber-optic cable, that the Commission charge market-rate rent for use of those facilities, charge Duke that much.

Calendar Item 50 & 51: Commission listened to staff presentation pertaining to the consideration of offers to dedicate access easements in Malibu. The item was approved by unanimous vote.
