RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Raymond Haywood, Jr. Kimberly D. Fonseca

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, along the Garden Highway, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

The construction, use, and maintenance of a boat dock and gangway.

LEASE TERM:

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Ten years, beginning April 1, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the upland adjoining the lease premises and have applied for a lease. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905(c)(1).

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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
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
