RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Warren Lewis Simmons, Jr. and Nancy Gale Simmons of the Warren Lewis Simmons, Jr. and Nancy Gale Simmons Trust, dated March 21, 1988

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, McKinney Bay, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier, boat lift and two mooring buoys as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning October 4, 2003.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$300,000.

Other:

This lease is conditioned on Applicants obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoys within two years after the adoption of the Lake Tahoe Shorezone Amendments-Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and approval of the ordinances based on the EIS.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 On October 26, 1996, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease to Warren Lewis Simmons, Jr. and Nancy Gale Simmons of the Warren Lewis Simmons, Jr. and Nancy Gale Simmons Trust dated March 21, 1988, for an existing pier, boat lift and two mooring buoys. That

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lease expired on October 3, 2003. Warren Lewis Simmons, Jr. and Nancy Gale Simmons of the Warren Lewis Simmons, Jr. and Nancy Gale Simmons Trust dated March 21, 1988 have applied for a new lease. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.

Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
