RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Rubik Moradian and Wendi Moradian

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Donner Lake, Truckee, Nevada County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Construction of a new pier as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning April 1, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The Applicants own the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicants are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling. Rubik Moradian and Wendi Moradian are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c)(1).


