GENERAL LEASE - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

LESSEE:

City of San Clemente Community Development 910 Calle Negocia, Suite 100 San Clemente, CA 92673

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.04 acres, more or less, of tide and submerged lands in the Pacific Ocean near the San Clemente Pier, San Clemente, Orange County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Construction and maintenance of a public beach access facility at the North Linda Lane railroad under crossing adjacent to the beach, northwest of the San Clemente Pier; use of a temporary beach front construction area and the repositioning of existing rip rap to protect the proposed public access facility.

LEASE TERM:

19 years, beginning February 2, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

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Combined single limit coverage of no less than \$1,000,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Applicant has a license agreement with the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), a public entity, for the use and operation of the property lying landward and adjacent to the Lease Premises.

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CALENDAR ITEM NO. C39 (CONT'D)

- The Applicant proposes to construct a public beach access ramp in an 2 area adjacent to the OCTA operated railroad corridor, which runs parallel to the beach within the city of San Clemente. Perpendicular to the corridor at the North Linda Lane beach site is an existing storm drain box culvert that terminates at the seaward side of the tracks. The proposed project will utilize this existing culvert as a railroad under-crossing with a proposed pedestrian ramp structure tying into the outflow point and ramping to the beach. This facility will provide a handicap accessible route to the beach. Currently, pedestrian traffic regularly trespasses over the railroad tracks to gain access to the stretch of beach at Linda Lane. This ramp will provide only periodic handicap access, as storm runoff and high tides will affect the public's accessibility to the beach. The City proposes to include signs at this location to warn the public that this access facility may not be accessible during high tides, large surf or storms. Signs will direct the public to other access points in the vicinity.
- 3. This project is a component of the city of San Clemente's 2.27-mile pedestrian beach trail adjacent to the existing OCTA railroad corridor.
- 4. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this project by the city of San Clemente. The California State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document. A Mitigation Monitoring Program was adopted by the city of San Clemente.
- 5. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE OF A GENERAL LEASE - PUBLIC AGENCY USE, BEGINNING FEBRUARY 2, 2004, FOR A TERM OF 19 YEARS, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A PUBLIC ACCESS FACILITY ON THE LAND SHOWN ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; CONSIDERATION BEING THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETAY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST, AND WITH THE PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000 COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT.

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
