RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Steve C. Bohlmann and
Frances J. Bohlmann

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, near the city of Sacramento,
Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

The construction, use and maintenance of a new floating boat dock, gangway
and pilings.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 1, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

Other:

No activities are authorized and no facilities or improvements shall be
constructed on the lease premises until Lessee provides copies to staff, of
all necessary permits from the California Department of Fish and Game,
California Regional Water Quality Control Board, and the U.S. Army Corps
of Engineers including the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and NOAA
Fisheries Final Biological Opinion, if required.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Applicants own the upland adjoining the lease premises.
2. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15303.

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

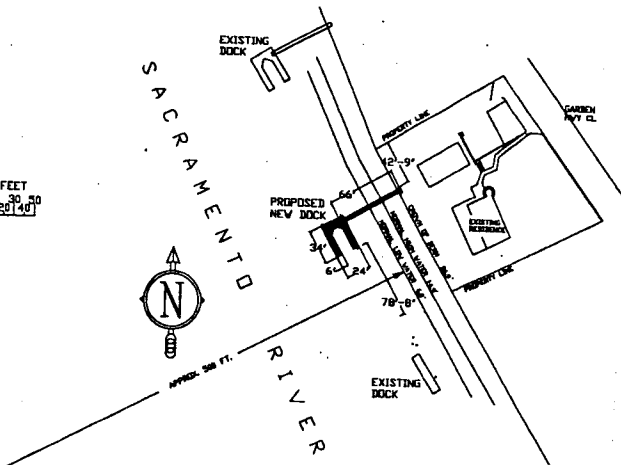
SIGNIFICANT LANDS INVENTORY FINDING:

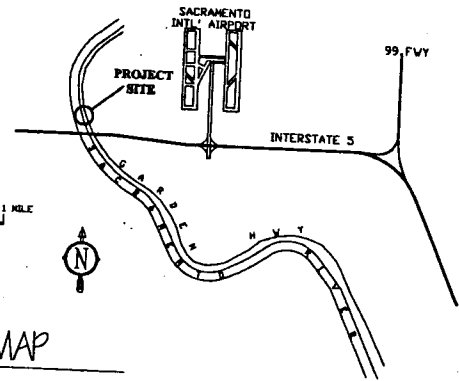
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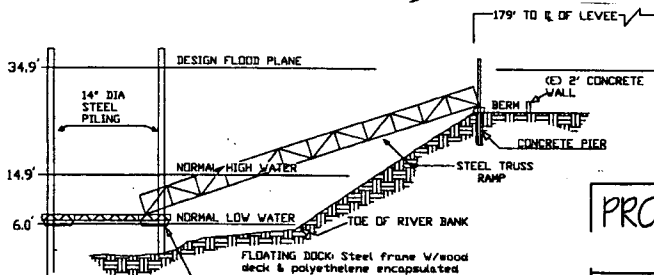
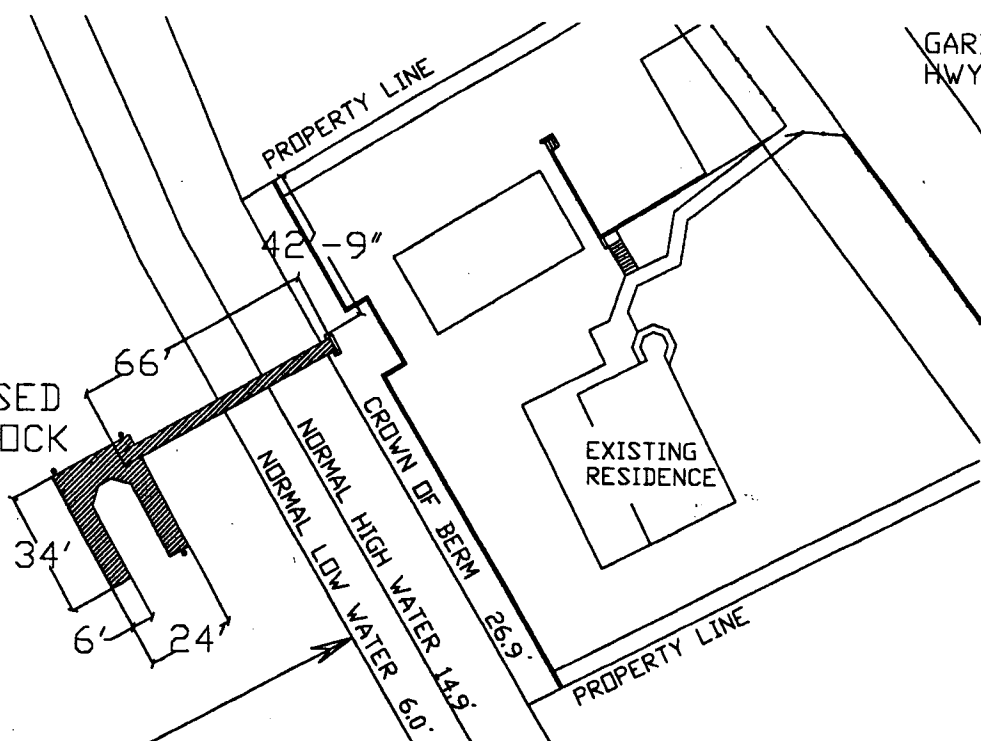
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VICINITY MAP

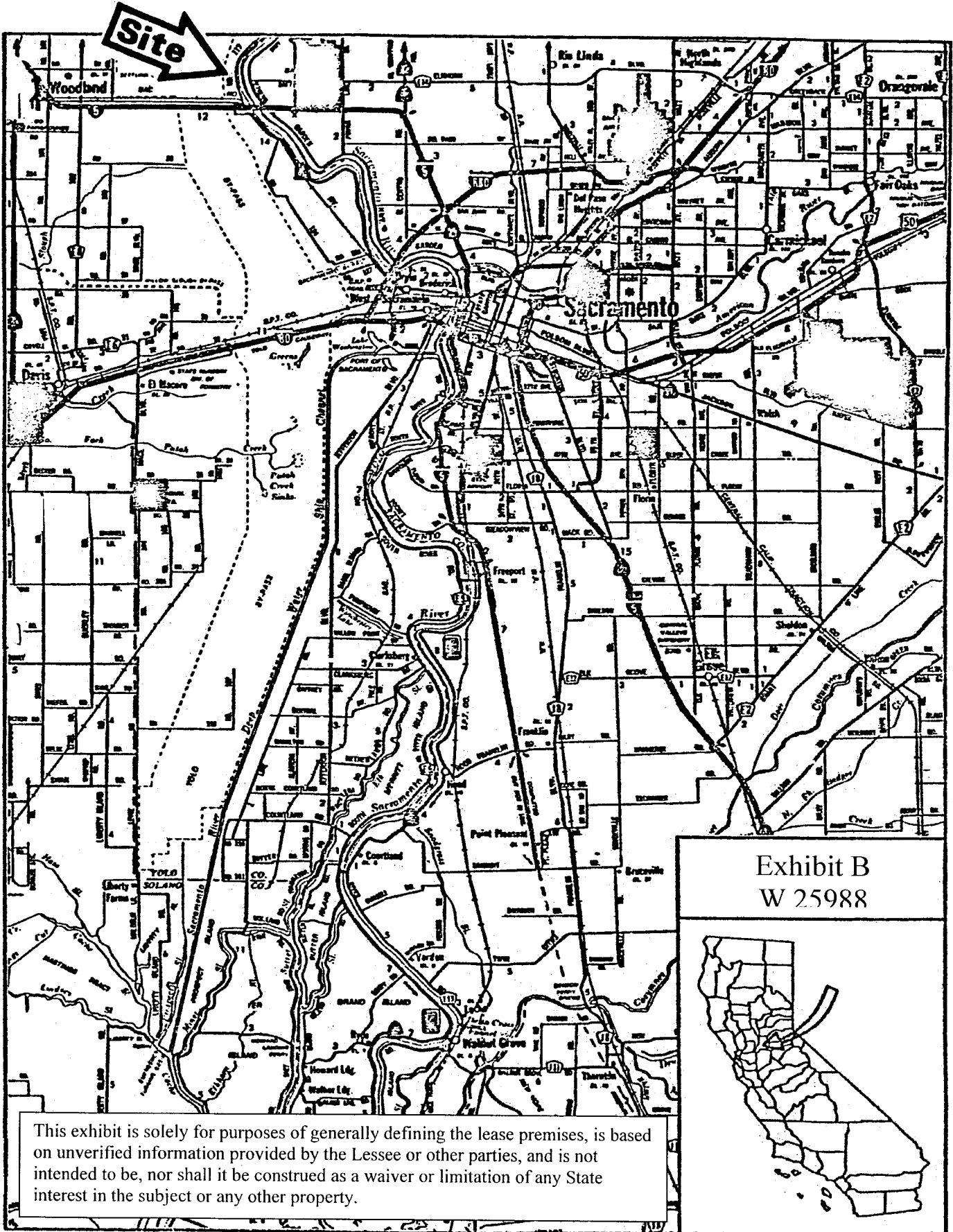
