APPLICANTS:

Leo H. Winters and Marilyn B. Winters, Trustees, Leo H. Winters and Marilyn B. Winters Revocable 1989 Trust.

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, Carnelian Bay, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing, previously authorized pier, and one mooring buoy, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning May 1, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the upland property adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. The Commission previously authorized the issuance of a Recreational Pier Lease to the Applicants. That lease has expired and the Applicant's are now applying for a new lease for the existing pier and buoy.

Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.






