APPLICANTS:

Paul Minasian, Trustee of the trust established under the will of P. J. Minasian as to an undivided one half interest; and Paul Minasian, Malcolm Minasian, and Regina Minasian Ambrose, Co Trustees of the Jean R. Minasian Trust uad 4/26/83 as to an undivided one half interest.

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, Carnelian Bay, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier and retention of two mooring buoys, not previously authorized by the Commission, as shown on Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning October 6, 2004

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

Other:

This lease is conditioned on the Applicants obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoys within two years after the adoption of the Lake Tahoe Shorezone Amendments-Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and approval of the ordinances based on the EIS.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 On August 30, 1989, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Jean R. Minasian and Paul Minasian, Malcom Minasian and

Regina Minasian Ambrose, Trustees of the Jean R. Minasian Trust. Since the lease was issued, the trust has been amended and ownership has been divided to the current family trusts each with one-half interest in the littoral property. Applicants have submitted an application for a Recreational Pier Lease.

- 2. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.

The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c)(3).




