LESSEE:

California-American Water Company 1019 Cherry Avenue Imperial Beach, California 91932-1609

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

2.25 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in San Diego Bay, near San Diego and Coronado, San Diego County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of a 24" diameter water transmission line.

LEASE TERM:

49 years, beginning May 29, 1969.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that the rent be revised from \$5,186 per year to \$12,724 per year, effective May 29, 2004.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- At its meeting on May 29, 1969, the Commission authorized the issuance 1. of a 49-year General Lease - Right of Way to California-American Water Company for the installation and operation of a 24" diameter water transmission line that provides water to Coronado.
- The water line has a cathodic protection system, which is tested annually. 2. Commission staff has reviewed the results of the 2004 Annual Cathodic Protection Test and believes the water line is adequately protected and fit for continued service.


