DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

Continental Maritime 1995 Bay Front Street San Diego, CA 92113-2122

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Ungranted tide and submerged lands and legislatively granted tide and submerged lands, with minerals reserved to the State, at Pier 6. Port of San Diego, San Diego Bay, San Diego County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Maintenance dredge approximately 10,000 cubic yards of material to restore the designed -36 MLLW depth; Dredged material will be disposed of at Lakeside Landfill, Otay Class III Landfill, or a similar approved upland disposal site.

LEASE TERM:

Five years, beginning February 18, 2005.

CONSIDERATION:


No monetary consideration will be charged. The dredged Material will not be sold. The project will result in a public benefit.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The subject project is located within ungranted tide and submerged lands in San Diego Bay lying waterward of the U.S. pierhead line and within tide and submerged lands legislatively granted to the San Diego Unified Port District, pursuant to Chapter 67, Statutes of 1962 and as amended, with minerals reserved to the State.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulation, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from

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the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304(g).

Authority: Public Resource Code section 21804 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Codes section 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


