Sovereign lands in the San Joaquin River, city of Isleton, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing two berth floating boat dock, platform, pilings and ramp.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning April 1, 2005.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- On May 3, 1995, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with James C. Scott and Carole Ann Scott; that lease expired on March 31, 2005. Applicants are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under




