CONTINUATION OF RENT

LESSEE:

William W. Duffin

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.04 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in the Petaluma River, at Black Point, Marin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of a walkway, pier, and a portion of a residence.

LEASE TERM:

15 years, beginning November 18, 1995.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that rent be continued at \$346 per year, effective November 18, 2005.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Lessee owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises, located in the Petaluma River, near Black Point, Marin County.
2. On August 21, 1996, the Commission authorized a General Lease – Recreational and Residential Use to William W. Duffin for the continued use and maintenance of an existing walkway, pier, and a portion of a residence. No changes to the authorized improvements have been made.

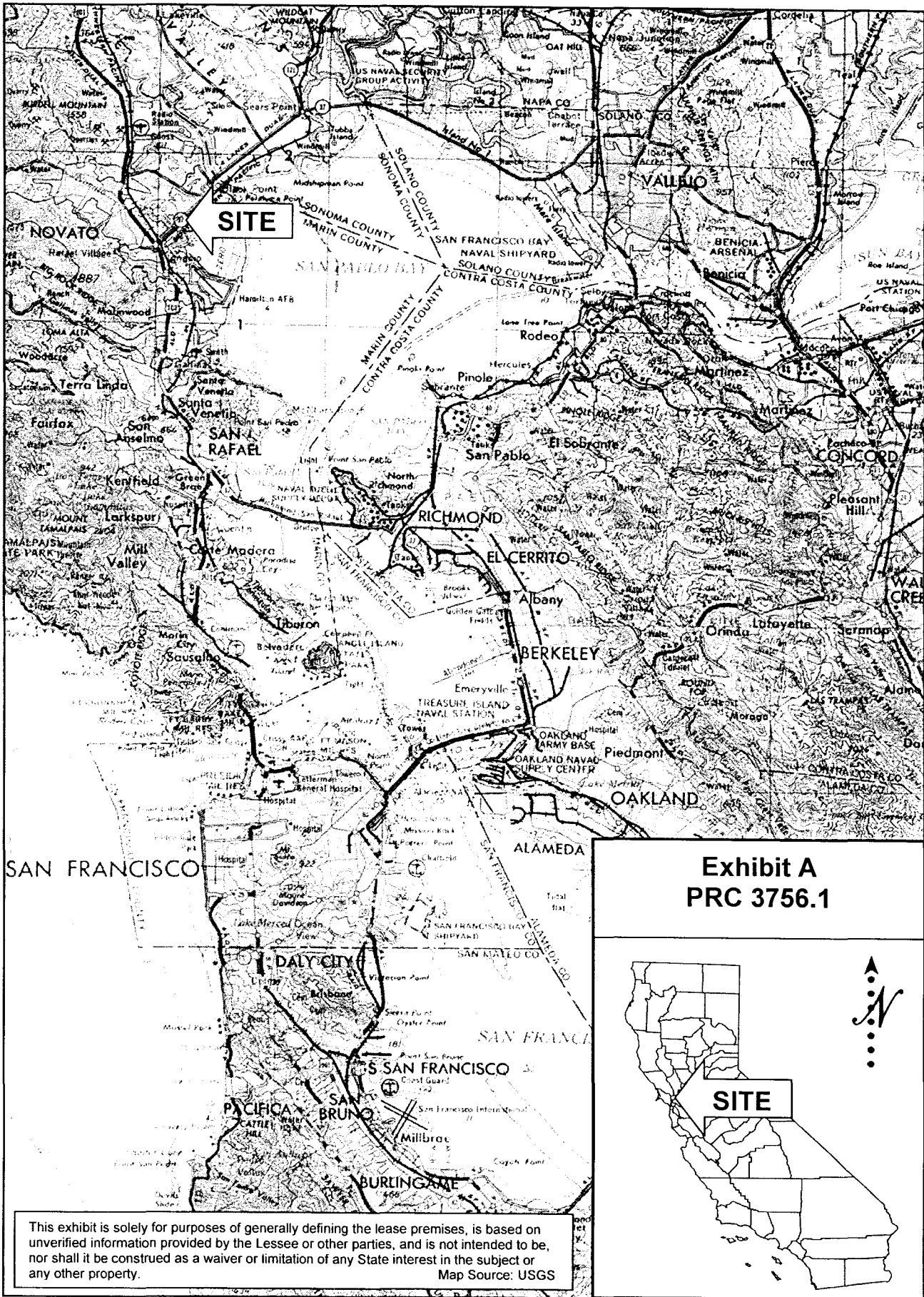
