OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- On March 6, 1991, the Commission authorized two General Leases Right-Of-Way Use to Kern River Gas Transmission Company for the construction, use and maintenance of a 36-inch diameter natural gas pipeline that crosses two parcels of State school land in San Bernardino County. The leases were issued for a term of 30 years, beginning March 7, 1991. The existing natural gas pipeline is an interstate pipeline that begins in Wyoming and terminates at Daggett, California in San Bernardino County. The pipeline is under the authority of the Federal Department of Transportation (DOT) pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 192, and was last inspected in June 2004 with no deficiencies reported.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines [Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15060(c)(3)], the staff has determined that this activity is not subject to the provisions of the CEQA because it is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.




