AMENDMENT OF DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

City of Berkeley – Office of Capital Projects 1947 Center Street, 4th Floor Berkeley, CA 94704

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Legislatively granted sovereign lands with minerals reserved to the State; located in San Francisco Bay at the Berkeley Marina, Alameda County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Dredge a maximum of 252 cubic yards of material at Docks H-I over five years to maintain a navigable depth. Dredged material will be disposed at an authorized upland disposal site.

LEASE TERM:

Five years, beginning March 1, 2005.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

The previous Lease, authorized by the Commission on February 17, 2005, permitted the maintenance dredging of a maximum of 252 cubic yards of material at Docks H-I between March 1, 2005, and February 28, 2010. This Amendment authorizes the maintenance dredging of a maximum of 8,750 cubic yards of material at Docks A-E over five years, beginning April 18, 2006. Dredged material at Docks A-E will be disposed at the United States Army Corps of Engineers designated disposal site SF-11 (Alcatraz). The dredged material may not be sold.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration will be charged. The dredged material will not be sold.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The material at Docks A-E is to be removed from a portion of the toe of the adjacent shoreline slope to allow adequate depths for navigation and a new dock configuration. In so doing, the project is expected to enhance and maintain the navigability of the Berkeley Marina.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (d)(4).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
