CONSIDER ACCEPTANCE OF A TRANSFER OF JURISDICTION FOR THE FUTURE TIDAL INLET CHANNEL AND A PERMANENT EASEMENT FOR BEACH NOURISHMENT ADJACENT TO THE INLET CHANNEL FOR THE BOLSA CHICA LOWLANDS RESTORATION PROJECT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, AND AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS TO CARRY OUT THESE TRANSACTIONS

STAFF REPORT: As a requirement of the Bolsa Chica Lowlands Restoration Project (Project), it will be necessary to construct a tidal inlet channel connecting the ocean with the full tidal basin. Rock jetties will also be built on both sides of the ocean inlet. The inlet channel will be constructed across Bolsa Chica State Beach, under the jurisdiction of the California Department of Parks and Recreation (Parks).

In a previous authorization, the Commission approved acceptance of an easement for the inlet channel across the beach as well as a temporary construction easement for the staging area for the inlet, and the necessary right-of-way for the Pacific Coast Highway Bridge and approach readway for use by Caltrans (Calendar Item C50, June 7, 2004). Parks has determined that a transfer of jurisdiction over the area for the inlet channel and jetties to the Commission would be more appropriate than an easement. In addition, the Project will provide beach nourishment to the areas adjacent to the jetties when required. Parks has determined that a permanent easement for this purpose would be appropriate.

As consideration to Parks for all of the interests in land needed by the Project, the Commission previously authorized the purchase of materials for sand fencing and installation of a right-of-way fence along Pacific Coast Highway adjacent to the beach.

- Government Code section 14673 provides, in part: "The jurisdiction of 1. real property owned by the state may be transferred from one state agency to another state agency with the written approval of the director [of the Department of General Services]."
- 2. The Commission certified the Bolsa Chica Lowlands Restoration Project (Project) Final Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement, adopted Findings, adopted a Mitigation Monitoring Program. adopted a Statement of Overriding Considerations, and approved the Project on January 30, 2002. The NEPA lead agencies issued the Record of Decision in the second quarter of 2002.

Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15025), the staff prepared an EIR/EIS identified as CSLC EIR/EIS No. 712, State Clearinghouse No. 2000071068. Such EIR/EIS was prepared and circulated for public review pursuant to the provisions of the CEQA.
