LEASE TERM:

One year, beginning August 24, 2006, to August 23, 2007.

CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged for the dredged material as the project will result in a public benefit. Dredged material may not be sold.

- 1. The Commission approved the issuance of a Dredging Lease to the Lessee at the August 24, 2006, Commission Meeting.
