**CONSENT TO THE POOLING OF ALL OR PART OF THE
LEASED LANDS UNDER NEGOTIATED SUBSURFACE
(NO SURFACE USE) LEASE NO. PRC 8674.1
SOUTH MOKELUMNE RIVER AND BEAVER SLOUGH,
SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Negotiated subsurface (no surface use) Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8674.1 contains approximately 13.74 acres of tide and submerged lands in the bed of the South Fork of the Mokelumne River and Beaver Slough in San Joaquin County, California.

BACKGROUND:

Negotiated subsurface (no surface use) Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8674.1 (Lease) was entered into on April 17, 2006, between the California State Lands Commission (Commission) and Towne Exploration Company (Towne). On May 10, 2007, the Commission approved an assignment of an undivided 40 percent (40%) interest from Towne (Assignor) to Capitol Oil Corporation (Assignee), effective June 1, 2007. Towne continues to be the operator of this lease.

Paragraph 22(b) of the lease allows Towne, as the Lessee, with the consent of the State and under terms and conditions approved by the State, to pool or unitize all or part of the leased lands with lands held by Towne or others. Towne is forming an operating unit that, based on current geologic interpretation, contains a total of 70.71 acres of State and private leased lands (described in Exhibit A, attached hereto). Towne's unit is called the "Gamble 13-2 Unit" and is being created for the development and production of natural gas. Towne has

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requested the Commission's consent to the pooling of 6.60 acres of leased lands under Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8674.1 by approving Towne's Declaration of Pooling for the "Gamble 13-2 Unit" dated June 6, 2007. The Commission staff has made a thorough review of the supporting materials used by Towne to form its unit and agrees with Towne's geologic interpretation, subject to review after the well is drilled. Staff has determined that there is no geologic or engineering reason not to pool the leased land and that it will be economically advantageous to the State to share in any production from the unit.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

- A. Public Resources Code, sections 6829.2 and 6832 and Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8674.1, paragraph 22(b).

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Towne has proposed to drill the "Gamble 13-2 Unit" well from a surface location adjacent to the State lands. The well would be drilled directionally through the leased lands to a completion location outside of the State lands. The proposed drillsite is on land where the "surface estate" and "mineral estate" are not owned by the same parties (i.e., a "split" estate). A dispute exists between Towne, as the mineral estate owner, and the surface owner of the proposed drillsite location as to Towne's right to burden the surface owner's land for the drilling of this well. The pending litigation may affect the timing and location of the proposed well, but is unlikely to affect whether the well is actually drilled.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines [Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15060(c)(3)], the staff has determined that this activity is not subject to the provisions of the CEQA because it is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

CONSENT IS GIVEN BY APPROVING TOWNE'S PROPOSED DECLARATION OF POOLING DATED JUNE 6, 2007, WHICH CREATES THE "GAMBLE 13-2 UNIT" DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT B, ATTACHED HERETO, (APPROXIMATELY 70.71 ACRES, WHICH INCLUDES 6.60 ACRES OF LEASED LANDS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE NO. PRC 8674.1). IF THE WELL IS PRODUCTIVE, STAFF SHALL REVIEW THE DRILLING RECORD OF THE WELL AND RE-EXAMINE THE STATE'S EQUITABLE INTEREST FOR CONSISTENCY WITH THE PROPOSED UNIT. THE UNITIZED LEASED LANDS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF OIL AND GAS LEASE NO. PRC 8674.1, ANY CONDITIONS IN THE DECLARATION OF POOLING TO THE CONTRARY NOTWITHSTANDING.

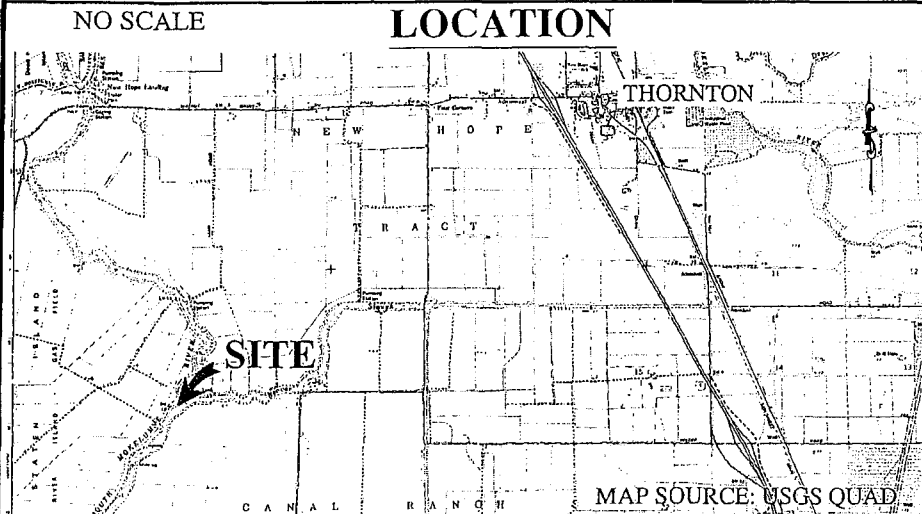
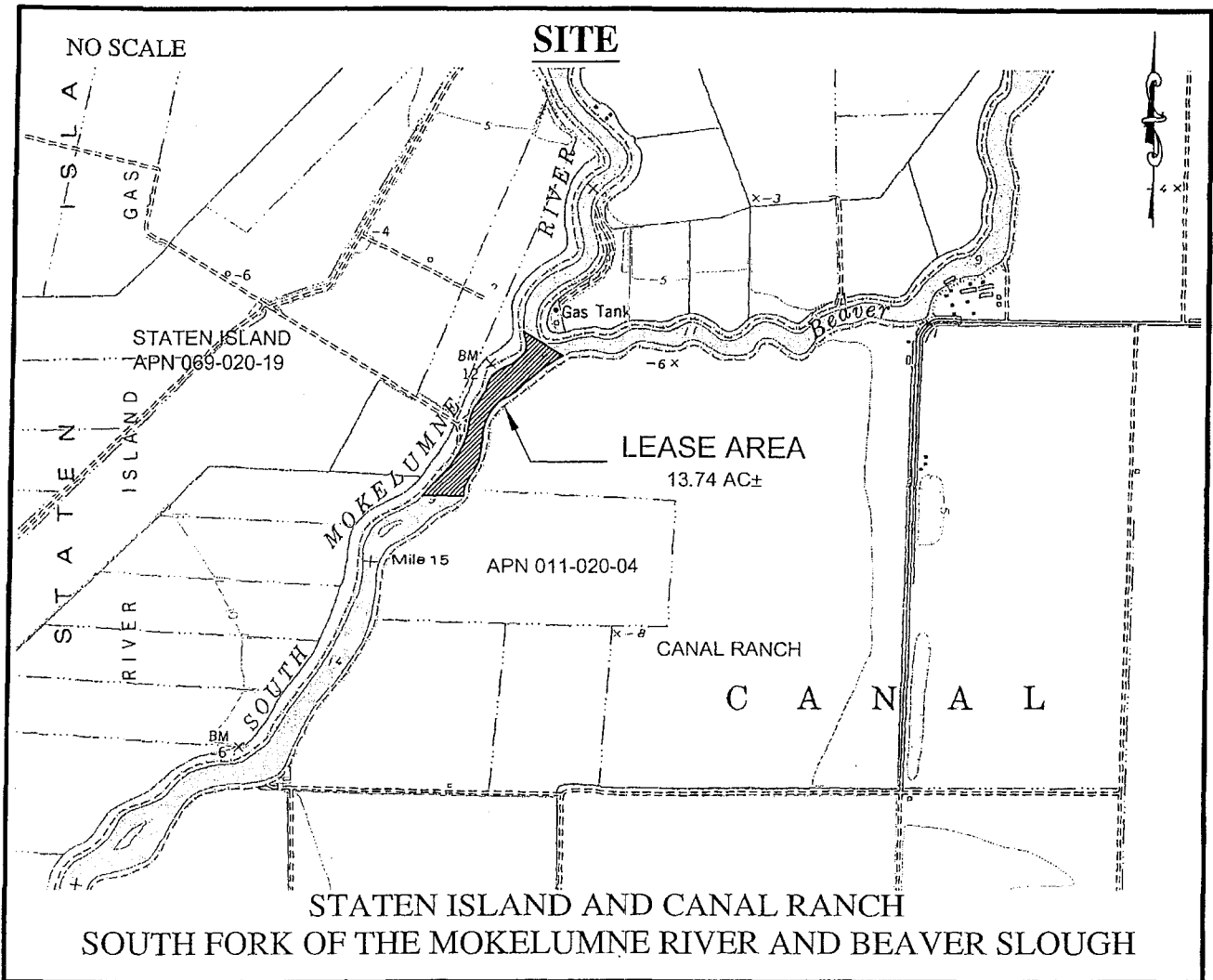

EXHIBIT B

DECLARATION OF POOLING

This DECLARATION OF POOLING is made this 6th day of June, 2007, by Towne Exploration Company ("Lessee"), whose address is Post Office Box 520, San Francisco, CA 94104-0520.

Lessee owns and holds of record leasehold estates created by certain oil and gas leases and fee mineral interests, the short forms or memoranda of which are described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein (collectively the "Leases"). Lessee, in order to facilitate the orderly development of the Leases and to promote the conservation of oil, gas, and associated substances, desires to combine, unitize, and pool the Leases, as herein expressed.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to and in exercise of the rights granted the Lessee in each of the Leases and effective as of the effective date set forth below, Lessee hereby combines and pools the Leases, insofar as they cover the lands within the operating unit designated the Gamble 13-2 Unit, more particularly described in Exhibit B attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein, containing 70.71 acres, more or less, located in San Joaquin County, California for the development and production of oil, gas and associated substances. A plat depicting the pooled unit is attached as Exhibit "C" and by reference incorporated herein. Oil, gas, other hydrocarbons and any other mineral substance produced in association therewith as a constituent part of the production stream shall be allocated among the parcels included within the Gamble 13-2 Unit in the same proportionate shares as the surface area for any given parcel shall bear to the sum of all the surface area for all the leased parcels within the Gamble 13-2 Unit.

That portion of Section 13, Township 4 North, Range 4 East, MDB&M and Section 18, Township 4 North, Range 5 East, MDB&M, also being a portion of Swamp and Overflowed Land Survey No. 1224, in the County of San Joaquin and State of California, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Easterly bank of the South fork of the Mokelumne River, distant, on a bearing of North 28°38'50" West, 1274.51 feet, more or less, from the Southeast corner of said Section 13; thence from said point of beginning, South 63°26'06" East 314.23 feet; thence East 462 feet; thence North 61°30'16" East 262.84 feet; thence North 53°22'43" East 353.22 feet; thence North 68°10'47" West 638.22 feet to CCS 27, Zone 2 coordinates of North=192600, East=2150400; thence North 59°02'10" West 55.15 feet to the Easterly bank of said South fork of the Mokelumne River; thence along said bank, South 52°48'54" West 134.36 feet, South 48°55'06" West 339.5 feet, and South 58°22'58" West 299.23 feet to the point of beginning, containing 9.60 acres, more or less.

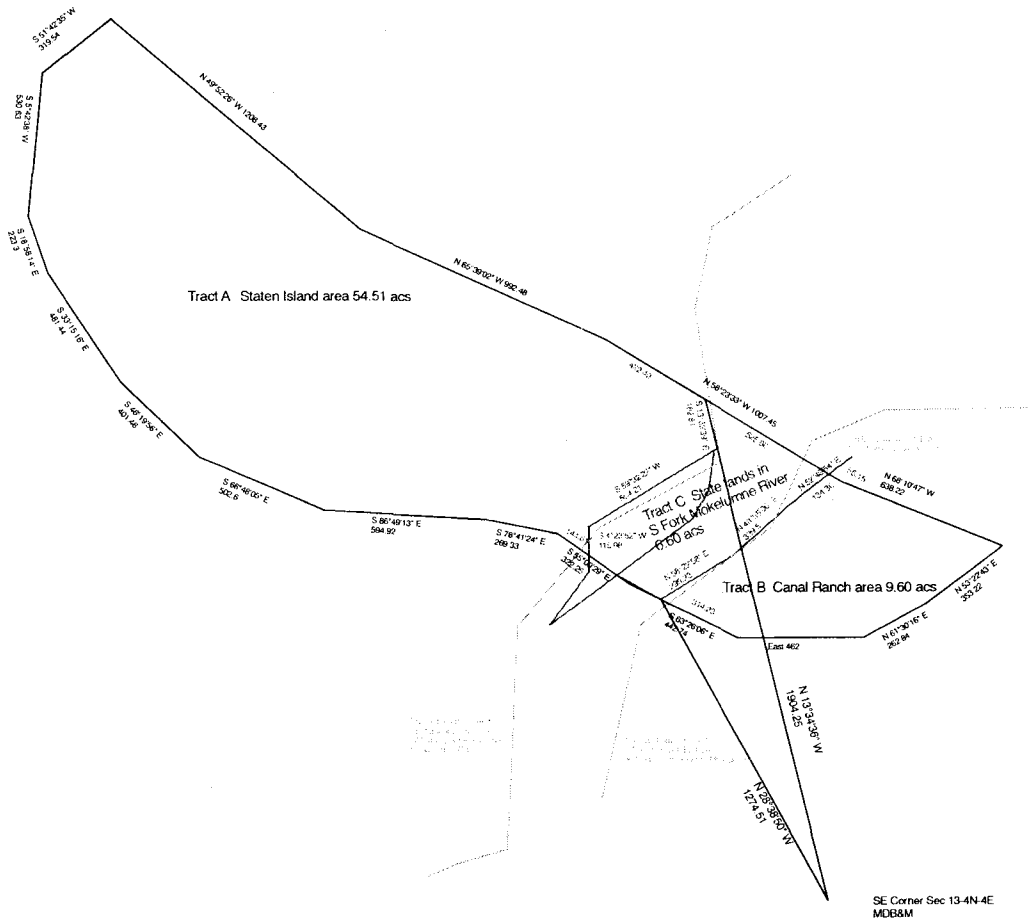
