#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Carnelian Bay, Placer County.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier and mooring buoy as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

#### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning May 1, 2007.

#### CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

#### **SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:**

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On February 27, 1998, the Commission authorized a ten-year Recreational Pier Lease to Hazel C. Indig, Trustee of the Indig Family Trust. The lease expired on April 30, 2007. The property has since transferred to Vicki Indig Smith, Trustee of the Indig-Smith Trust dated June 23, 2006. The Applicant is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.

- 3. The Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the trustee is a natural person who owns the littoral land which is improved with a single-family dwelling.
- 4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).
