#### TERMINATION OF A RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE AND ISSUANCE OF A NEW RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

#### LESSEES:

Franco Vianello and Jane N. Vianello

#### **APPLICANTS:**

Sean Pramuk and Robin L. Thompson

#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Napa River, near the city of Napa, Napa County.

#### AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing uncovered floating boat dock, walkway and ramp as shown on Exhibit A.

#### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning September 13, 2007.

#### CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

#### SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

#### **OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

- 1. Applicants own the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On June 19, 1998, the Commission issued a Recreational Pier Lease to Franco Vianello and Jane N. Vianello for an existing walkway, ramp, and uncovered floating boat dock. That lease was scheduled to expire January 21, 2008. The upland property has since been deeded to Sean Pramuk and Robin L. Thompson, who have now applied for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Staff is recommending termination of the

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existing lease and issuance of a new lease, to be effective September 13, 2007.

- 3. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who own the littoral land that is improved with a single-family dwelling.
- 4. **Termination of Existing Lease:** Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines [Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15060(c)(3)], the staff has determined that this activity is not subject to the provisions of the CEQA because it is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21065 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, sections 15060 (c)(3) and 15378.

5. **Issuance of New Lease:** Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

6. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.



- 2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO SEAN PRAMUK AND ROBIN L. THOMPSON OF A TEN-YEAR RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE, BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 13, 2007, FOR THE CONTINUED USE AND MAINTENANCE OF AN EXISTING UNCOVERED FLOATING BOAT DOCK, WALKWAY, AND RAMP AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; NO MONETARY CONSIDERATION PURSUANT TO PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTION 6503.5; LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF NO LESS THAN \$300,000.

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
