AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.095 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in Little Fisherman's Cove, Santa Catalina Island, Los Angeles County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Construction, use and maintenance of a temporary seasonal floating dock as shown on Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning May 10, 2007.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. On May 10, 2007, the Commission authorized a ten-year General Lease Recreational Use to the Lessee for the construction, use and maintenance of a temporary floating dinghy dock to improve access to the Lessee's upland leasehold in Little Fisherman's Cove, Santa Catalina Island.
- 2. On October 31, 2007, the Lessee notified staff it had decided to cancel its plans to construct the dock. Since the lease was executed, staff is requesting that the authorization made by the Commission at its May 10, 2007 meeting for Minute Item C40 be rescinded.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15060(c)(3), the staff has determined that this activity is not subject to the provisions of CEQA because it is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.
