RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Terrie Lyn Hansen

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, adjacent to 4527 West Lake Boulevard, near Homewood, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier and two mooring buoys as shown on Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 31, 2008.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$500,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On February 8, 2000, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Gennora Mobraten, as Trustee of the Gennora Mobraten Personal Residence Trust, Established July 10, 1997. That lease expired on August 30, 2008. The littoral land was subsequently deeded to Terrie Lyn Hansen. The Applicant is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.
- 3. The current pier configuration differs slightly from the configuration previously authorized by the Commission. Per the Applicant, the pier was built in 1978 and storm damage repairs were performed in 1998. The

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Applicant does not have any additional records of the pier construction and repairs. Commission staff contacted the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency and was advised that there were no additional records or permits for the littoral parcel after 1978.

- 4. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who owns the littoral land that is improved with a single-family dwelling.
- 5. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

6. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
