AREA, LAND TYPE AND LOCATION:

Negotiated subsurface (no surface use) State Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8674.1 (Lease PRC 8674.1) contains a parcel of tide and submerged land in the bed of the South Fork of the Mokelumne River and Beaver Slough situated in San Joaquin County, California. The parcel contains approximately 13.74 acres, and is located within the California Division of Oil, Gas and Geothermal Resources' (DOGGR) District 6, River Island Gas Field.

BACKGROUND:

Lease PRC 8674.1 was issued on April 17, 2006, to Towne Exploration Company (Towne) for a term of three (3) years. At its meeting on May 10, 2007, the California State Lands Commission (Commission) approved the assignment of an undivided forty percent (40%) interest of Lease PRC 8674.1 to Capitol Oil Company (Capitol) effective June 1, 2007. On May 5, 2008, the Commission approved the assignment of all forty percent (40%) of Capitol's interest in Lease PRC 8674.1 to ABA Energy Corporation (ABA) effective June 1, 2008.

On March 17, 2006, Towne applied to the DOGGR for a permit to drill well "Gamble" 13-2 in San Joaquin County near Lease PRC 8674.1. However, this well was never drilled and the permit was canceled on April 9, 2008. As a result, Towne and ABA submitted on April 17, 2009, via email, a document entitled "Surrender of State Oil and Gas Lease" quitclaiming Lease PRC 8674.1.



SURRENDER OF STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE

State Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8674.1 (Lease), covering certain State lands located in San Joaquin County, State of California, was issued to Towne Exploration Company (Lessee) by the State of California, acting through the California State Lands Commission (State), on April 17, 2006, and was recorded in the Official Records of San Joaquin County, at document number 2006-118599, on June 1, 2006.

Towne Exploration Company (Assignor) assigned forty percent of its undivided right, title and interest under State Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8674.1 to Capitol Oil Corporation (Assignee). At its meeting on May 10, 2007, the State Lands Commission approved said assignment effective June 1, 2007. It was recorded in the Official Records of San Joaquin County, at document number 2008140477, on August 27, 2008.

Capitol Oil Corporation (Assignor), as holder of an undivided forty percent (40%) interest, assigned all of its undivided right, title and interest under State Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8674.1 to ABA Energy Corporation (Assignee). At its meeting on May 5, 2008, the State Lands Commission approved said assignment effective June 1, 2008. It was recorded in the Official Records of San Joaquin County, at document number 2008-144575, on September 3, 2008.

Towne Exploration Company and ABA Energy Corporation(Lessees) are the present holders of the Lease.

Pursuant to the terms of State Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8674.1, the Lessees may make at any time a written quitclaim or relinquishment of all rights under this Lease or of any portion of the leased lands comprising a ten-acre parcel or multiple thereof in a compact form, or of any separate or distinct zone or geological horizon or portion thereof underlying a ten-acre parcel or multiple thereof in a compact form.

Acting in accordance with such terms, the Lessees do hereby release, remise and forever surrender and quitclaim unto the State of California all of their right, title and interest in and to the State lands held by virtue of State Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8674.1, which lands are described in the attached Exhibit A.

LAND DESCRIPTION
