REVISION OF RENT

LESSEE:

Tri-Valley Oil and Gas Co.

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land located in Piper Slough and False River, near the town of Bethel Island, Contra Costa County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing six-inch diameter welded steel natural gas pipeline as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

20 years, beginning October 16, 1996.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends rent be revised from \$315 per year to \$551 per year, effective October 16, 2011.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- On October 28, 1996, the Commission authorized a General Lease –
 Right-of-Way Use to the Tri-Valley Oil and Gas Co. for the construction of
 a six-inch diameter welded steel natural gas pipeline buried beneath the
 bed of Piper Slough and False River using horizontal direction drill
 construction. This pipeline connected Tri-Valley's existing Webb Tract #1
 gas well to Tri-Valley's existing Martins-Serverin gas gathering system
 near Bethel Island Road.
- 2. The pipeline underwent a Cathodic Protection Test in March 2010 and, as a result, no repairs or modifications were made within the lease area.




