RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Raymond M. Snow, Trustee of the Raymond M. Snow Trust dated December 10, 1991

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in Eagle Lake, adjacent to 691-20 Lakeside Drive, near Susanville, Lassen County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing seasonal portable floating dock on wheels as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning September 1, 2010.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$500,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On September 19, 2000, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Raymond M. Snow, Trustee of the Raymond M. Snow Trust dated December 10, 1991. That lease expired on August 31, 2010. Applicant is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.
- 3. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who owns the littoral land that is improved with a singlefamily dwelling.
- 4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, §15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1,

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.
