STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE PRC 8618.1 FROM STREAM ENERGY, INC. TO
SUMMIT EXPLORATION (CALIFORNIA), LLC, AND APPROVE SUMMIT
EXPLORATION (CALIFORNIA), LLC AS OPERATOR OF THE LEASE,
SACRAMENTO RIVER AND GEORGIANA SLOUGH,
SACRAMENTO COUNTY**

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Negotiated subsurface (no surface use) State Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8618.1 currently contains approximately 37.41 acres of tide and submerged land situated in the bed of the Sacramento River and Georgiana Slough in Sacramento County, California.

BACKGROUND:

State Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8618.1 was originally issued to Stream Energy, Inc. (Stream) on June 20, 2005. The original lease contained approximately 17.91 acres of tide and submerged land in the bed of the Sacramento River and Georgiana Slough in Sacramento County. On March 25, 2008, the California State Lands Commission (Commission) approved an amendment to add approximately 19.5 acres to the lease for a total of 37.41

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acres and pooled all of the leased lands into two units: the CT-KD Unit and Shoreline Pooling Unit. The annual rental for the entire lease is \$950 and the royalty is fixed at 20 percent on all gas and oil substances produced.

PROPOSED ACTION:

Stream has submitted assignment forms requesting Commission approval to assign an undivided 75 percent of its interest in the lease to Summit Exploration (California), LLC (Summit). Summit has also applied to be named the new operator for this lease. Staff has reviewed all requisite financial documentation submitted by Summit and has determined that Summit is capable of meeting the financial obligations set forth in the lease. Summit has provided an Irrevocable Letter of Credit (ILOC) as security and will be responsible for making all rental and royalty payments due under the lease.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines [Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15060, subd. (c)(3)], the staff has determined that this activity is not subject to the provisions of CEQA because it is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21065 and California Code of Regulations, Title 14, sections 15060, subdivision (c)(3), and 15378.

2. The applicant has completed the assignment forms, paid the filing fees and has filed an ILOC in the amount of \$10,000 as required by the terms of the lease.
3. In addition, Summit maintains a blanket oil and gas indemnity bond with the Division of Oil, Gas & Geothermal Resources (DOGGR) in the amount of \$100,000 to cover all well operations.

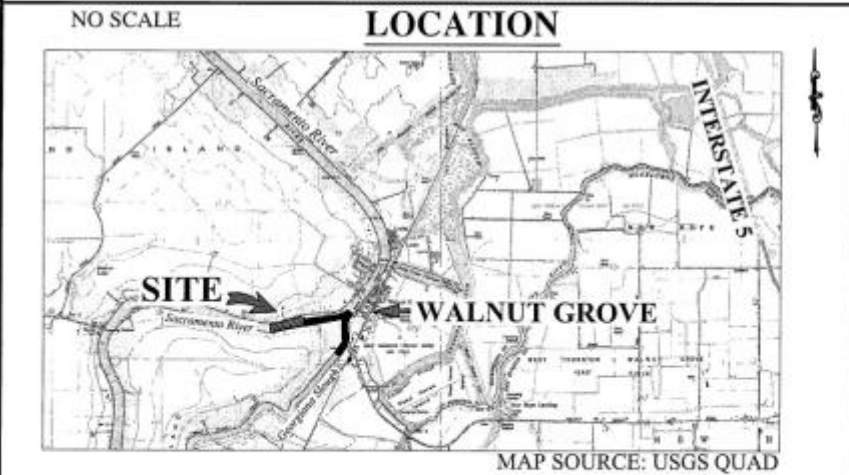
It is recommended that the Commission:


