GENERAL LEASE - COMMERCIAL USE

APPLICANTS:

William D. Watkins and Denise P. Watkins Trustees of the Watkins Family Trust Dated 1-7-94

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in Lake Tahoe, adjacent to 6980 West Lake Boulevard, near Tahoma, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier and five mooring buoys.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning March 5, 2014.

CONSIDERATION:

\$2,392 per year, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided for in the lease.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in an amount no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On August 8, 2005, the Commission authorized a 10-year General Lease Recreational Use to William D. Watkins and Denise P. Watkins, Trustees of the Watkins Family Trust Dated 1-7-94. That lease expired March 4, 2014. The Applicants are now applying for a new lease.
- 3. The upland adjacent to the lease premises is improved with a motel/lodge. The pier and five mooring buoys are for use by the guests of the lodge.

- 4. The five existing mooring buoys were permitted by the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency on April 10, 1981.
- 5. The staff recommends that the Commission find that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; California Code of Regulations, Title 2, section 2905, subdivision (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15300 and California Code of Regulations, Title 2, section 2905.

6. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6370 et seq., but such activity will not affect those significant lands. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Commercial Use to William D. Watkins and Denise P. Watkins Trustees of the Watkins Family Trust Dated 1-7-94 beginning March 5, 2014, for a term of 10 years, for the continued use and maintenance of an existing pier and five mooring buoys as described on Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B (for reference purposes only) attached and by this reference made a part hereof: annual rent in the amount of \$2,392, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease; and liability insurance in an amount no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

PARCELS 2 & 6 – BUOYS




