# CONSIDER APPLICATION FOR A NON-EXCLUSIVE GEOPHYSICAL SURVEY PERMIT ON TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN SAN PABLO BAY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE CALIFORNIA STATE LANDS COMMISSION

#### **APPLICANT:**

United States Geological Survey Pacific Coastal and Marine Science Center Attn.: Dr. George Tate 400 Natural Bridges Drive Santa Cruz, CA 95060

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The United States Geological Survey has applied for a low-energy inland waterway Geophysical Permit. These permits are issued to qualified companies to perform geophysical surveys of bays and rivers for purposes such as geotechnical investigation of seismic hazards, sand erosion and deposition studies, optic cable routes, oil and gas pipeline routes, harbor facility bathymetric changes, submerged hazards and debris, and/or location of sunken boats and airplanes. These low-energy surveys typically use equipment such as side-scan sonar and magnetometers. Air guns and other sources of high energy are expressly prohibited in the permit. Upon request, the California State Lands Commission (Commission) will receive copies of all data derived from any and all surveys under the permit.

#### TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

One (1) week, beginning October 5, 2014, through October 11, 2014.

#### PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Required fees, expense deposit, and other security have been received.

This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6370 et seq., but such activity will not affect those significant lands. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
