GENERAL LEASE – RECREATIONAL USE

LESSEE:

Catherine Amatruda

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in the Petaluma River, adjacent to 45 Hillside Terrace, near Novato, Marin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Use and maintenance of an existing walkway, boathouse and pier.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning July 26, 2014.

CONSIDERATION:

\$159 per year, with an annual Consumer Price Index adjustment.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Lessee owns the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On December 9, 2004, the Commission authorized issuance of Lease No. PRC 3541.9, a General Lease – Recreational Use, to Roy Kaltschmidt and Catherine Amatruda for a period of 10 years, for use and maintenance of an existing walkway, boathouse, and pier. The lease expired on July 25, 2014. The Lessee is now applying for a new lease.
- 3. The staff recommends that the Commission find that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; California Code of Regulations, Title 2, section 2905, subdivision (a)(2).

AUTHORIZATION:

Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational Use to Catherine Amatruda, beginning July 26, 2014, for a term of 10 years, for the use and maintenance of an existing walkway, boathouse and pier as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B (for reference purposes only) attached and by this reference made a part hereof; annual rent in the amount of \$159, with an annual Consumer Price Index adjustment; and liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
