## AMENDMENT OF LEASE AND REVISION OF RENT

### LESSEE:

Rick L. Antle and Tonya Antle; and Michael D. Cling and Mary Jean Cling

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in Lake Tahoe, adjacent to 8833 Winston Way, near Rubicon Bay, El Dorado County.

### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier, boat lift, and two mooring buoys.

### LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning October 19, 2012.

### **CONSIDERATION:**

This lease provides that the Commission may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease and recommends that rent be revised from \$1,538 per year to \$1,227 per year, effective October 19, 2017.

### PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Amend the lease to replace the existing Exhibit A, Land Description, and Exhibit B, Site and Location Map, with the attached Exhibit A, Land Description, and Exhibit B, Site and Location Map (for reference purposes only). All other terms and conditions of the lease shall remain in effect without amendment.

### STAFF ANALYSIS AND RECOMMENDATION:

### Authority:

Public Resources Code sections 6005, 6216, 6301, 6501.1, 6503, and 6503.5; California Code of Regulations, title 2, sections 2000 and 2003.

### **Public Trust and the State's Best Interests Analysis:**

On October 19, 2012, the Commission authorized a 10-year General Lease – Recreational Use to Rick L. Antle and Tonya Antle; and Michael

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D. Cling and Mary Jean Cling, for an existing pier, boat lift, and two mooring buoys (<u>Item C52</u>, <u>October 19</u>, <u>2012</u>). That lease will expire October 18, 2022.

Staff conducted the rent review called for in the lease and recommends the rent be revised from \$1,538 per year to \$1,227 per year based on changes to the lease (impact) area for the pier and application of the Lake Tahoe Benchmark. Staff also recommends the lease be amended to reflect the new reduced lease area.

The lease does not alienate the State's fee simple interest or permanently impair public rights. The recommended action will not substantially interfere with the Public Trust needs at this time and at this location. For these reasons, staff recommends finding the proposed action is in the best interests of the State.

### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. This action is consistent with Strategy 2.2 of the Commission's Strategic Plan to ensure timely receipt of revenues and royalties from the use and development of State lands and minerals.
- 2. Amendment of the lease to make an adjustment in the lease area and approving the revision of the rent are not projects as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act because they are administrative actions that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21065 and California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15378, subdivision (b)(5).

### **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

It is recommended that the Commission:

### **PUBLIC TRUST AND STATE'S BEST INTERESTS:**

Find that the proposed actions will not substantially interfere with the Public Trust needs and values at this location, at this time or for the foreseeable term of the lease, and are in the best interests of the State.

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### **AUTHORIZATION:**

- 1. Authorize the amendment of Lease No. PRC 8471.1, a General Lease Recreational Use, effective October 19, 2017, to replace the existing Exhibit A, Land Description, and Exhibit B, Site and Location Map, with the attached Exhibit A, Land Description, and Exhibit B, Site and Location Map (for reference purposes only).
- 2. Approve the revision of rent for Lease No. PRC 8471.1 from \$1,538 per year to \$1,227 per year, effective October 19, 2017.

### LAND DESCRIPTION

Three (3) parcels of submerged land situate in the bed of Lake Tahoe, lying adjacent to Lot 2 of fractional Section 32, Township 14 North, Range 17 East, MDM., as shown on Official Government Township Plat approved July 29, 1880, County of El Dorado, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

### PARCEL 1-PIER

All those lands underlying an existing pier, catwalk and boat lift lying adjacent to Parcel One as described in that Grant Deed recorded September 16, 2011 in Document Number 2011-0043210 in Official Records of said County.

TOGETHER WITH Any applicable impact area(s).

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion(s) lying landward of elevation 6223 feet LTD on the shoreline of said Lake Tahoe.

PARCELS 2 & 3 - BUOYS (2)

Two (2) circular parcels of land, each being 50 feet in diameter, underlying two (2) existing buoys lying adjacent to that Parcel as described in said Grant Deed.
