PROCEEDINGS

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CHAIRMAN MC CARTHY: Open Session. We'll begin with the open session.

The minutes of the last Commission meeting are approved without objection.

Executive Officer.

EXECUTIVE OFFICER WARREN: Mr. Chairman,

Commissioners, we have one item on the calendar today,
which will be presented to you by our General Counsel,
Mr. Hight.

MR. WIGHT: Mr. Chairman, we're here today to seek authorization for a settlement with four of the remaining oil companies -- Texaxo, Exxon -- Texaco, Mobil, Shell, and Standard Oil for \$180 million. This would settle the State's and the City of Long Boach's claims against the companies for Long Beach 1 and Long Beach 2, the two lawsuits which have been brought against the companies for alleged price fixing.

In addition, the companies will make all of their nonheated pipelines common carrier. Three companies have heated pipelines. They will be adjudicated in an arbitration proceeding. And one company, Shell, has requested, at the State's option, that we consider up to \$10 million worth of property exclusively at the State's

option. 1 2 It's the staff's recommendation that you approve 3 this item that has previously been approved by the Long Beach City Council, and the Attorney General has indicated 4 approval and will sign today. 5 CHAIRMAN MC CARTHY: Any questions? 6 COMMISSIONER BURTON: I have a question about 7 timing. 8 COMMISSIONER TUCKER: We can't get it this 9 afternoon. 10 COMMISSIONER BURTON: Which fiscal year --11 MR. HIGHT: This fiscal year. 12 COMMISSIONER BURTON: -- will this be settled 13 in terms of the cash? 14 MR. HIGHT: This fiscal year. 15 COMMISSIONER BURTON: Okay. 16 EXECUTIVE OFFICER WARREN: Within 45 days or 17 so, 60 days? 18 COMMISSIONER BURTON: 60 days from the last 19 20 signing? 21 MR. HIGHT: Yes. COMMISSIONER BURTON: I see. Thanks. 22 EXECUTIVE OFFICER WARREN: That concludes the 23

CHAIRMAN MC CARTHY: Jim, have you had a chance

presentation.

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(Laughter.)

COMMISSIONER TUCKER: I'll get to it sooner or

CHAIRMAN MC CARTHY: Do you have any further

impressions?

It's a good settlement, and for those, including Jim. The Long Eeach City Attorney, it's a good settlement. We could always hope for \$200 million more, but I think that we got a good deal. All things considered, it's a good result.

And we all have our ideas on how the cash should be spent. But I think a contingency of one-third to the State Lands Commission budget is very reasonable. Don't you agree?

EXECUTIVE OFFICER WARREN: It would be much appreciated.

COMMISSIONER BURTON: It would be if it weren't spent already.

I had one more question. My understanding is that this also requires approval by the Governor.

MR. HIGHT: Yes.

COMMISSIONER BURTON: And I want to make sure that he has available to him a copy of the settlement documents as soon as possible.

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MR. HIGHT: I sent to Janice Brown one of the settlement documents last Thursday, and with any kind of luck, he should have the entire package on his desk this afternoon.

COMMISSIONER BURTON: When are you expected to close all of the -- complete the process?

MR. HIGHT: Well, we expect to have everybody's, except for the Governor's, signature this afternoon.

So, the Governor should have it this aftern on or in the morning at the very latest.

COMMISSIONER BURTON: And this will be the first time that Janice has seen the package?

MR. HIGHT: No. Janice has seen -- they're all identical. And this is the Mobile package, which I gave Janice Thursday.

COMMISSIONER BURTON: Okay. Thank you.

CHAIRMAN MC CARTHY: Any other thoughts on this?

Are we prepared to approve?

COMMISSIONER TUCKER: Yes.

CHAIRMAN MC CARTRY: All this with the c veat it needs the Governor's signature. All right. Commission approved.

EXECUTIVE OFFICER WARREN: That concludes the agenda.

CHAIRMAN MC CARTHY: Thank you very much.

EXECUTIVE OFFICER WARREN: Thank you.

MR. HIGHT: Thank you.
